Minutes of General Meeting
April 28, 2016

President **Margie Murphy** called the meeting to order at 10:04 am. She said that we need a meeting just to talk. She read the motto and purpose of the OGC. The best part about our OGC is all of the wonderful members and their amazing participation.

Treasurer **Sandy Barnett** passed out copies of next year's budget and announced that **D.D. Felton** is the treasurer elect. **Sandy** moved and **Cathleen Sodos** and **D.D. Felton** seconded and the Administrative budget passed as presented. Regarding the Contribution Budget, the monies from the Garden Tour last year are ear marked for the Median project. **Sandy** moved and Kristen Whitsett seconded and the Contribution Budget passed. **Sandy** then presented the Donations to Institutions which will increase for next year. **Carole Wolfman** suggested we add a donation to Save the Bay in honor of the 1/20/16 passing of Sylvia McGaughlin. **June Cunningham** asked about the Ruth Bancroft Garden and **Sandy** said she would add back \$250 as a donation. It was suggested that Penny Pines be paid out of the funds so that on one has to do this monthly and count the change; however, June Cunningham spoke up and wanted to do that task for next year. **Sandy** moved and **Connie Leach** seconded and the \$2,850 non profit donation budget passed.

She said a holocaust survivor spoke to Miramonte students. The girls' basketball team placed second in the State with Sabrina leading the scoring.

Cathleen Sodos complimented our 2015-2016 new members. **Gail Emmons** will again do a flower arranging workshop for them and they will go to a Piedmont Garden Tour. Three ladies were offered membership for next year: two will defer and Gwen Manfrin accepted for this upcoming year.

Laura Sawczuk announced that pay pal may be used to pay your dues as well as check or cash. Actives: \$290 (\$297 with pay pal,) Associates/Sustainers: \$170, and new members \$410. Deadline for dues is 5/31/16 to **Laura**.

Linda Thompson and **Kristen Whitsett** reported on their trip to Washington D.C. to attend the NAL conference 2/22/16-2/25/16 and thanked the club for sending them. There were 280 GCA members and 30 speakers. There is an article on the GCA website. The financial impact of global warming, climate change, preventative measures, water quality, National Parks, Measure AA, Student Conservation Association were some of the topics. Jan Formanek passed around a clipboard for everyone to make changes to the roster. She pointed out the issue that small binders no longer are available in green.

Phoebe Kahl showed photos from Bouquets to Art at the de Young Museum. If passed it will levy a parcel tax of \$12 per year to restore tidal marshes, build Bay trails etc. She passed out and collected ballots which showed an overwhelming support for Measure AA from members. **Kristen** noted that Measure AA is consistent with our OGC purpose. She encouraged us to vote for Measure AA.

Margene Stahle asked us to sign up to bring flowers to the Orinda Library. Two arrangements are to be delivered to the library on Mondays.

Yoni Mayeri was accepted as a GCA photography judge.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:16.

Pamela Croce Goode introduced our speaker: Michael Kabler from Oaktown Bloom. He used colored vases with armiture glued onto them. He used curly willow instead of a frog. He always uses odd numbers of stems and has them start from the same spot. He puts a drop of bleach to extend floral life into the water and changes the water everyday.
